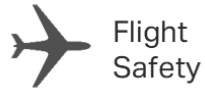

Climate Change: our 4-prong approach

New aircraft

We have 30 new Airbus A350 aircraft in service since 2016. They can improve fuel efficiency by up to 25%. 71 more new aircraft is on firm orders.



Biofuel

We are the first airline committed to taking 375m of biofuel in the next 10 years. We have been using biofuel consistently since 2016.

Operation

We have improved fuel efficiency by 28% since 1998, avoided 70m tonnes of CO2. We have been reducing aircraft weight and optimizing other operations to reduce fuel usage.



Carbon offset

We are the first airline in Asia to offer carbon offset for passengers since 2007. We also offset staff duty travel flights on our network.

Fly Greener

What you as a passenger can do to fly greener?

Since 2007 we have run the Fly Greener programme to help customers reduce the carbon generated from their air travel in a credible and simple way.

We source carbon credits from independently reviewed and accredited projects that actually reduce CO2 emissions. All money paid for the offsets goes directly to the running of these projects and Cathay Pacific does not profit from this transaction in anyway. Our current projects included include community focused efficient cooking stoves and biogas digesters.



Sustainability in Operations: use of resources and waste management



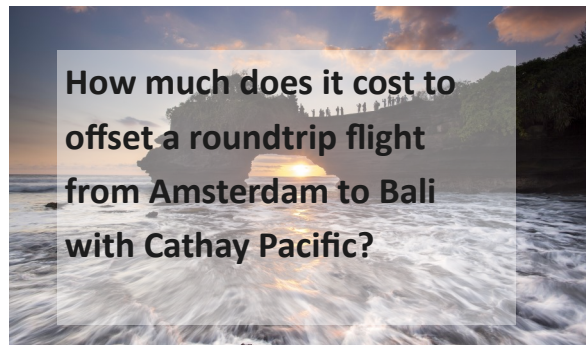
Plastics • Plastic cutlery of Cathay flights are washed and reused
• Plastic straws and stirrers would be phased out on all flights and worldwide lounges in 2019
• Economy Class blankets and carpets inflight are made from recycled plastic and nylon wastes.



Recycle • In-flight waste sorting and recycling started since 2006.
• Total weight of waste recycled was over 3010 tonnes in 2017, that is equivalent to 15 A350-900 aircraft.



Food • 260 tonnes of unopened food and beverages from our operations were donated to local food banks in 2017.
• Active sourcing of more sustainable and locally produced food options.
• Serving sustainable seafood since 2010.
